Galeria Tonantzin, a gallery of women's contemporary art, directed by women artists Jennifer Colby and Janet Martinez is named for the Mexican Goddess Tonantzin whose characteristics were transferred to the Virgin of Guadalupe. The 800 sq. ft. Adobe is a great venue for this exhibit co-sponsored by the MBWCA. **San Juan Bautista** is a unique historic California Mission Town, situated inland from the Monterey Bay on the San Andreas Fault. We feature an artist reception along with the San Juan Bautista Art Gallery Walk on the second Saturday of each month. For this exhibit, the receptions will be on June 13 and July 11, 5 - 7 p.m.

The theme of this exhibition is Women's art that celebrates, interprets and investigates TREES. By inviting women across the United States, we hope to show the diversity of human relationships to TREES from Coast to Coast

EXHIBITION GUIDELINES - \$10 JURY FEE AND \$35 HANGING FEE PER ARTIST. (JURY FEE WAIVED FOR MEMBERS OF WOMEN'S CAUCUS FOR ART.)

All work must be created by women, in any media, 2D or 3D ready to be hung (framed as appropriate with wire in back.) We use "s" hooks and hang by white string. **All work must be for sale.** Artist may submit up to three entries. The Gallery will withhold 40% commission from your retail price. Size of artwork is limited by ability to ship or hand deliver. Work must be available for the entire **two months** of the exhibit.

Artists selected will be responsible for shipping their work **by May 29, 2009** to the gallery accompanied by the **\$35 hanging fee per artist payable to Galeria Tonantzin.** Work will be insured at wholesale value by the gallery upon receipt. Artist is responsible for insurance while shipping. Artist is responsible for return shipping unless sold. A prepaid shipper and return label must accompany the artwork. Artwork must be shipped in reusable packaging. (No styrofoam peanuts accepted.) Hand delivery and pickup by appointment only. Abandoned artwork becomes the property of the Gallery 30 days after the exhibit ends. Ship accepted artwork by US mail to P.O. Box 606 or by UPS or Fed Ex to 115 Third Street, San Juan Bautista, Ca. 95045 to be received by May 29, 2009.
